Nota general: Title devised by cataloger Included are nine prints from the de' Rossi series of papal portraits: Innocent X, Urban VIII, Alexander VII, and their successors from Clement IX to Clement XI, which are bound before those of cardinals they created. An engraved frontispiece with Giovanni Giacomo de' Rossi's imprint appears before the portrait of Innocent XI; it was intended for a portrait series of cardinals created by Innocent. The volume as a whole must have been assembled after the date of the final cardinal's creation by Clement XI in 1711, and probably before Clement's death in 1721, as of all the papal portraits only his has no added death date Printmakers include: Robert van Audenaerd, Charles Audran, Barend de Bailliu, Anton Birkhart, Jacques Blondeau, Albert Clouet, Girolamo de' Rossi, Nicolas Dorigny, Benoît Farjat, Jakob Frey, Giuseppe Maria Testana, Benoît Thiboust, Arnold van Westerhout
