Within the second decade of the 21st century we are witnessing a golden age of space exploration cinema in spite of other action genres, such as thriller or war film. This phenomenon has promoted traditional values of the American dream like the refoundation of home, the search of prosperity, or a sense of mission. This is also a tendency in contrast with the filmic "spectacles of the destruction" which, according to experts like Dixon, Kellner or Quart and Auster, dominate a culture of the apocalypse established in the first decade of the century.
