The Madeira Photography Museum-Atelier Vicente's is located in the Vicente's Photography Studio (1863-1978), the oldest one in Portugal at present. It was first acquired by Vicente Gomes da Silva (1827-1906) in 1865. The collection includes several original pieces connected with the photographic activity, such as theater sets, cameras, furniture, technical books and a valuable photographic archive, with an estimation of three or four million of copies. Besides the Vicente's fund which dates back to the fifties, the collection keeps the work of other professional and amateur photographers who stayed in Madeira, and in addition, it has a nucleus related to cinema. The Regional Government of Madeira, bought the entire collection of this studio in 1979, which after undergoing restoration, it started as the Photographia-Museu Vicentes. In 2014, the museum closed for refurbishment works and opened again on July 2019 with the present name. In 2020, it was awarded the 'Best Museum of the Year' by the Portuguese Association of Museology

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
